What To Expect

- Mixture of different activities which will be run by Frank Chapman staff during the day.
- May include: shelter building, orienteering, forest walks, time on the adventure playground, games and sports etc.
- Evenings will be spent socialising, watching DVD's, playing games etc.

Travel

- Children will be travelling together on one coach.
- Leaves school at 9.30 on the 15^h
- Due to return to school around 2.45 on the 17th
- Children to be dropped off and collected from the school hall on those days. Please drop children off at the normal time.
- We will send out an updated time for arrival back to school once we have left Frank Chapman on Wednesday.

Accommodation

- Breakfast, lunch and evening meal is provided. Dietary requirements will be taken into account (as long as we know about them!).
- Children will sleep in single-sex dorms together. Sleeping arrangements will be allocated on arrival.
- Staff have separate rooms but will always be available and the children will know where we are if needed.

Requests

Please don't allow children to bring mobile phones or other electronic equipment.

Children will be provided with plenty of healthy, filling food by the centre and so extra snacks are not necessary.

Money

- There is a shop on site that children can buy souvenirs from.
- Children can bring a maximum of £5 to spend.
- Please hand in the money clearly labelled in an envelope on the morning of the trip.
- Money will be looked after by a member of staff. Children will be offered a choice of goody bags by the centre staff up the value of £5.
- Unspent money will be returned at the end of the trip.

Illness/Medication

- If your child is taking any prescription medicine, this needs to be handed in on the morning of the trip and you will need to complete a consent form before we can administer any medicine.
- Make sure it is clearly labelled and that the instructions for administering the medicine are clear.
- There are trained first aiders at the centre who can look after children who may be ill or who may hurt themselves whilst we are away.
- If necessary we will contact parents and for serious illness/injury it may be necessary for the child to return home.
